**Footnotes**

BRAT MAVERICK was unhurried early while on the outside, rallied into the stretch and circled the field, drew off under heavy pressure. BLAZING FOREST dueled for the lead and set the pace while saving ground, could not go with the winner late but was clearly second best. TONYO dueled for the lead and prompted the pace from the outside, flattened out and ran evenly late. PATCHED was unhurried early on the inside, rallied on the turn, failed to sustain the bid and began to fade in the stretch. NAPOLEON J flashed brief speed before stopping. DISTRESS SIGNAL was in a good stalking position in mid pack, had no rally. OHIO SMILE was no factor.
