JOE SIX PACK was unhurried early while on the outside, rallied into the stretch and wore down the leaders, drew off late while drifting out. TAINTED WITNESS was void of early speed, rallied into the stretch, could not get to and was no match for the winner, was clearly second best. LT. PAT dueled for the lead and set the pace while saving ground, weakened in the stretch and began to fade. DETROIT'S DANCER showed good early speed, was through after a half mile and dropped back. RE LUHUK (ARG) flashed brief speed chasing the pace before weakening and dropping back. FLIP FLOP dueled for the lead early, was through after a half mile and faltered. TENCATI failed to menace while wide and lost ground. P. P'S TO FOLLOW was no threat. COUNT ONE flashed brief speed before stopping.
