MILADY'S HONOR settled in midpack early, angled out three wide midway on the turn, rallied to take the lead approaching the sixteenth marker under left handed urging and quickly drew clear. COSMIC SECRETS raced four wide while well off the pace on the turn, finished willingly and easily bested the rest. ONE NAUGHTY FOOL sprinted clear early, maintained her advantage to midstretch, tired through the final furlong and just saved third. ALWAYS GIVING chased the pace racing in the two path to the stretch before weakening. DOC DOT COM trailed while being outrun to the stretch, found her best stride much too late. TAKESALITTLERAIN chased the pacesetter while saving ground to the stretch, tired badly. DANCING NIJINSKY was sent along early, flashed brief speed, couldn't keep pace approaching the turn, stopped through the stretch and was not abused.
