BEVELHYMMER GIRL set the pace from the two path to the stretch, widened in upper stretch and maintained her advantage to the wire under urging. COAX ME KATINK raced well off the pace to the stretch, split rivals in upper stretch, finished willingly for the place. MERCY raced within range in midpack, angled out entering the lane, did not rally. MOMMA'S MONEY raced well off the pace to the stretch and passed only tired foes. REMORSEFUL raced well back to the stretch, was six wide entering the lane and never threatened. IRISH VISION was outrun. BUDAPEST STAR chased the winner to the stretch before tiring. KAITLYN'S AWARD was outrun. DEVILISH CANDY chased the pace to the stretch before tiring badly. SI MI BONITA vied for the lead inside of the winner on the backstretch, chased around the turn, faltered through the stretch.
