

BRIGHT PYRITE was unhurried early on the outside, rallied into the stretch and closed with a rush, was fully extended to begin to draw clear. CASEY'S JET bobbled at the start, had a late rally in the stretch and was gaining but too late. MISTY TAB was in a good stalking position in mid pack on the outside, rallied into the stretch and led late, was outfinished to the wire. JUST MICHEL pressed the pace from between horses early, rallied into the stretch and drew clear, weakened and ran evenly late. MONEY CARD was unhurried early on the outside, rallied into the stretch and loomed boldly, flattened out and ran evenly late. MAGG'S CHOICE prompted the pace from between horses early, rallied into the stretch and loomed a threat, faltered in the stretch and began to fade. STILL VOICE showed good early speed in mid pack, ran evenly and had no rally. LITTLEBITABLING showed good early speed while forced seven

wide and lost ground, gave way in the stretch and dropped back. SYBLES ANGEL dueled for the lead and set the pace from the inside, was used up and dropped back. BORN AT DAWN was well placed in mid pack, had no rally. DEMANDING was no threat. PAY THE MAN showed brief speed, gave way in the stretch and was not asked for run. DONAMOUR flashed brief speed dueling for the lead, stopped in the stretch and dropped back. CLOUD FORTY NINE was no factor.
