JUST MICHEL stalked the pace from the rail, was blocked behind runners in upper stretch, angled out for racing room approaching midstretch, swept past the leaders leaving the furlong marker and drew clear under steady handling. MONEY CARD raced close up while three wide to the stretch, bid outside rivals entering the lane, lugged in in upper stretch bumping a rival, was straightened and continued willingly to the wire for the place. IMAHONEYTOO raced in striking range in midpack to the stretch before finishing evenly. PEGGY'S RUBY dueled along the rail to midstretch before weakening. NACHEN showed little. PARTHENOPE held a narrow early advantage, dueled from the two path around the turn, was bumped while between rivals in upper stretch, tired. FOUR SPEED, NOON WIN and TAYLOR'S GIGGLE were all outrun. A claim of foul by the rider of PARTHENOPE against the runner up alleging interference in upper stretch was not allowed.
