PIPER'S FRIEND quickly to the lead, pressured the entire way, stayed gamely and edged away late. LUCKY MERLOT well placed while never far back, rallied into the stretch but was no match in the final sixteenth. PORTERVILLE pressured the winner from three wide throughout and was used up to weaken late. HUMBLE EARL far back early on, made up ground from outside through the stretch but was too late. RAT LIKE CUNNING raced evenly with no response when needed. MILL POINT stayed close for a half but faded after three quarters. KENNY THE SALESMAN failed to menace. STRAIT OF MEWSINA (IRE) was never a threat. MASS was no menace.
