ROCKIN INTHE RAIN was in a good stalking position while four wide early, rallied and drew off on the far turn, was under constant urging to the wire. DEAR JESSE was void of early speed, had a mild late rally and some late gain but too late. SAFARI DREAM was well placed in mid pack, rallied on the far turn and into the stretch, failed to sustain the bid and ran evenly late. BOLD PEAKS dueled for the lead and pressed the pace, faltered and faded. ENGLISH SPIRIT set the pace with good early speed, gave way and dropped back. TAPTOBE failed to menace. STARRING HAILE was no threat. SYBLES ANGEL dueled for the lead and pressed the pace, stopped and dropped back.
