HONEY BE FLEET dueled for the lead and set the pace while off the rail, took over in upper stretch and drew off under constant urging. WEATHER HEATHER was unhurried early, rallied into the stretch on the outside, failed to sustain the bid and ran evenly late. READY TO ROCK stalked and prompted the pace from the outside, weakened in the stretch and ran evenly late. ORIENTAL PRINCESS dueled for the lead and set the pace while saving ground, faltered and faded. JEANNE'S HERO flashed brief speed before stopping. IRISH VISION showed good early speed in mid pack, ran evenly with no rally. SUNSTRUCK failed to menace. LOLLICAT was no threat.
