MARIAH'S MOON unhurried early, had a steady advance towards the front on the outside, drew off under heavy pressure. SABER JET REPRIZED dueled for the lead early, was allowed to settle, could not go with the winner but gamely held the place. STRAWBERRY'S HEART was fractious entering the gate and delayed the start several minutes, stalked the pace early, rallied and led, hung in the stretch and ran evenly late. REDS CHILE was in a good stalking position in mid pack, ran evenly with no rally. SAMMY'S D J dueled for the lead and set the pace, faltered and faded. BALLARI stalked the pace with good early speed, gave way and dropped back. ROYAL RHAPSODY was no factor. SUNDAY BLESSING flashed brief speed, was eased in the stretch.
