CHIEF WINDSONG stalked the pace while never while never far back, rallied into the stretch and dueled for the lead, drew clear late under constant urging. CHASE THE BLAZE dueled for the lead and set the pace while off the rail, led to mid stretch, weakened late and ran evenly. M AND EM dueled for the lead and pressed the pace, ran evenly and lacked the needed closing response. CHAD'S HERO was in a good stalking position in mid pack, ran evenly and had no rally. GREEN JACKET was void of early speed, improved position but was no threat. DIPLOMA was no factor. FISTICUFF was well placed in mid pack, had no rally. J R'S COUNTLIBERTY failed to menace. VINDICATOR flashed brief speed chasing the pace before fading.
