### Footnotes

PAY THE MAN stalked the pace while four wide, rallied on the turn and took the lead, drew clear in late stretch under constant urging. INDIAN INK stalked the pace while never far back on the inside, rallied into the stretch and dueled, faltered but gamely held the place. HONEY BE FLEET was unprepared at the start and spotted the field several lengths, rallied into the stretch but bore in and bothered MAD JAZZ, had a late rally and some late gain but too late. DOUBLED VISION showed good early speed while five wide, gave way and dropped back. CACTUS HOUSE was in a good stalking position in mid pack, ran evenly with no rally. MAD JAZZ was unhurried early, rallied into the stretch, was taken up when HONEY BE FLEET bore in upper stretch, finished evenly. PRINCESS CHRISTINE failed to menace while six and seven wide. DERBY DAY STORM showed good early speed, was through after a half mile and dropped back. HAPPY WAC set the pace with good early speed, faltered and faded. M S ROXIE failed to menace.
