WEEKEND WONDER was in a good stalking position in mid pack, while five wide, rallied on the far turn and took the lead, drew clear in upper stretch, was under constant urging to hold sway late. TICONDERO was off a step slow and then stalked the pace from mid pack, had a late rally and was gaining but too late. BLUE LION duelled for the lead and set the pace from the outside, weakened in the stretch and ran evenly late. STEPHEN'S QUEST was void of early speed, rallied on the second turn, failed to sustain the bid and ran evenly late. MAGICAL PARK stalked the pace while saving ground, gave way and dropped back. TIO CHENCHO showed good early speed, faltered and faded. OUR KING set the pace with good early speed, stopped and dropped back. TENMOR failed to menace. CANDID IMAGE was no factor. WINGED WARRIOR was no threat.
