FLASHMANS PAPERS (GB) was in a good stalking position while five wide, rallied on the turn and into the stretch, drew clear under heavy pressure. MOONSHINE STILL was well placed on the inside, had a late rally in the stretch and was gaining but too late. DANCE FOR MILITARY dueled for the lead and set the pace, weakened in the stretch and ran evenly late. DELTA CHARLIE dueled for the lead and pressed the pace, faltered and faded. MY BEST CHANCE flashed brief speed, gave way and dropped back. G AREYOUKIDDING showed good early speed, was through after a half mile and dropped back. WHERE'S DENTON failed to menace. BIG PHONE BILL was no threat.
