RARE ACTION was well placed early, swung into the six path in the turn then rallied in the stretch and drew off late under a steady drive. BAHAMIAN TWIST was unhurried early, angled off the rail into the turn, made a bid in the stretch but was no match for the winner. COWGIRLS RULE dueled early, angled into the three path in the turn and weakened late. THEATER DISTRICT tracked the pace early, angled into the four path in the turn, took over and led in the stretch but faded in the final stages. HEY BEV dueled early from the inside, stayed on the rail into the turn and gave way in the stretch run. CANDY G angled into the five path in the turn while no threat. WHAT ATTITUDE was never a factor. FREE TO SWEEP showed little. RUN GIMA RUN was done early. HOLY QUAIL had early speed then folded up.
