SWISS MISS TOO pressed the pace early then took over command, while on the inside into the turn then drew clear in the stretch and held in the final stages. I'M KIDDIN was well placed early, angled into the five path in the turn then rallied in the stretch but missed in the final stages. DIAMOND INTHE FUNK tracked the pace early, angled off the rail into the turn and weakened late in the stretch run. JUSTLIKEHERMOTHER broke slowly from the gate, angled off the rail into the turn and moved up in the stretch drive. MAGNETISM was never involved. STELLAR D'ORO was done early. RIO SUNSHINE hesitated at the start and was outrun. WORTH IT ALL had brief speed then folded up.
