QUINN'S GOLD raced close up early, made a bid outside a rival entering the turn, dueled to the final sixteenth before drawing clear late under urging. COAX ME KATINK raced three wide in midpack on the turn, finished willingly and gained the place in the final strides. SI MI BONITA set the pace from the rail, was headed by the winner entering the turn, dueled to inside the final sixteenth before weakening late, just saved third while between rivals at the wire. IRISH VISION raced close up inside rivals on the backstretch, was shuffled back a bit entering the turn, chased from the two path on the bend, finished willingly inside rivals and narrowly missed the minor wards. REMORSEFUL showed little. DEVILISH CANDY vied for the lead from between rivals on the backstretch before retreating on the turn. BURNING BRIDGES broke slowly and was outrun.
