BETSY BEAR dueled for the lead and set the pace while saving ground, responded when asked in the stretch and drew off under heavy pressure. MY RESTLESS HEART was unhurried early, rallied on the second turn, failed to sustain the bid and ran evenly late. CONSOLIDATING was in a good stalking position while five wide, rallied on the second turn, bid and hung. RIVERLAND broke in the air, had a mild late rally and some late gain. MUFFIN MIX showed good early speed, faltered and faded. JOSHUA'S BREAK was well placed in mid pack, ran evenly with no rally. RAE OF SUN failed to menace. COWGIRL CODY was no factor. GIADA dueled for the lead and pressed the pace, stopped and dropped back.
