HAWKINSRIDGE was rank and throwing his head early, moved up quickly to take the lead and went clear on the backstretch, widened on the turn, remained well clear under urging despite failing to switch leads through the lane. ALLADINS CLOUD chased the winner to the stretch, never threatened that one but proved second best. SPUNKY WIND saved ground while moving into midpack on the turn, passed only tired rivals. NAPOLEON J chased the winner from the rail to the stretch before tiring. SETA GATO had brief speed from the rail, dropped back into midpack a half mile out and was not a factor thereafter. MUDDLE THRU IT, IN NAME ONLY and KNIGHTOFTHESTORM were all outrun. OUR ZING A ZONG raced outside rivals in midpack on the backstretch, stopped through the lane.
