### Footnotes

MOODY BRUCE stalked the pace in behind the dueling leaders and was in tight and checked repeatedly, was taken to the outside and rallied into the stretch, drew clear under firm handling. SILVER TALK RIB was unhurried early, rallied into the stretch widest of all and loomed boldly, failed to sustain the bid and ran evenly late. PREMIER COURT was in a good stalking position in mid pack, was steadied on the turn, ran evenly late and had no closing response. COUNT ON MY WORD was void of early speed, had a mild late rally and some late gain. DARE HE GOES was unhurried early, improved position but was no threat. CHASE THE BLAZE showed good early speed chasing the pace, gave way and dropped back. JOHN THE BANKER flashed brief speed before stopping. ALL STAR LOVER dueled for the lead early, faltered and faded. MCFRENCH showed good early speed, was through after a half mile and dropped back.
