SCIOTO BOOTSKI dueled for the lead from between horses on the backstretch and inside of MORE D'AMOUR on the turn, kicked clear in upper stretch and held sway late under urging. ATHENAVEGA raced within easy striking range while three wide in the second flight on the turn, finished willingly for the place without threatening the winner. LADY CHERIE raced well back early, swung wide approaching the stretch and finished fastest. LAND O HONEY raced just off the dueling leaders while saving ground on the turn but failed to produce a rally. MORE D'AMOUR dueled for the lead while racing three wide to the stretch, tired through the drive. BELLE OF LIBERTY raced well off the pace to the stretch before passing a few tired rivals. FAN'S ACCOUNT raced in midpack throughout and was never a factor. PLAID SKIRT was outrun. COED RUTH E. showed little. MANDY G raced in midpack on the backstretch before dropping back. MARY'S WILD FLOWER was outrun. DOM AND ROSES vied for the lead inside of the winner on the backstretch, slipped back on the turn and faltered.
