DANGEROUS CROSSING was void of early speed while six wide on the turn and lost ground, rallied into the stretch and wore down the leader while near mid track. TOP APPEAL stalked the pace from mid pack, rallied into the stretch and led late, was outfinished to the wire. PRIVATE HERB was unhurried early, rallied into the stretch and loomed boldly, failed to sustain the bid and ran evenly late. NAPOLEON J dueled for the lead and pressed the pace, led to upper stretch, drifted in late and ran evenly. CHEYENNE SPRING dueled for the lead from between horses, was steadied while tiring in the stretch, faded late. GAMBLIN CAPER dueled for the lead and set the pace, faltered in the stretch and faded. SAHAB flashed brief speed between horses, gave way and dropped back.
