SAILFIN dueled for the lead and set the pace, faltered and faded. APACHE STORM was in a good stalking position in mid pack, ran evenly with no rally. EL POLLO VOLANDO was well placed, rallied on the far turn and led, failed to sustain the bid and ran evenly late. WEEKEND WONDER failed to menace. BILLION BUCK BABY was no factor. TAX MAN SAM dueled for the lead and set the pace, gave way and dropped back. TARA BULL bobbled at the start, was no factor.
