Footnotes

STAND FAST rated just off the pace five wide early, stayed wide into the stretch to gain the lead and prevailed at the wire. COSIMO never far back, split horses through the late stretch and gained too late. TEE'S PROSPECT had a four wide trip, made a bid into the final furlong but flattened out in the drive. TRASH TO TREASURE had no speed to the stretch, rallied in the drive to finish well late. HOUSEBUILDER raced evenly and lacked the late response needed when called upon. LETEM FLY broke through gate pre start and was always outrun. HONOUR ABOVE SELF had good speed to vie between horses to the turn but stopped. SIXANDTHREE speed to duel from closest to the rail and gave way readily.
