DANCE TRIP stalked the pace while never far back, rallied and dueled for the lead, could not get to and was no match for the winner, was second best. CASA DE FUEGO dueled for the lead and set the pace, gave way and dropped back. ARIEL'S RYDER showed good early speed, gave way and dropped back. GOLDENTALEOFTEXAS was no factor. STONE QUEEN failed to menace. INDYS REALITY showed good early speed, faltered and faded. ARGO NAVIS was pinched back soon after the start, trailed in a dull effort.
