ACHIEVABLE was unhurried early while four wide, rallied on the far turn and into the stretch, drew off under heavy pressure. ORANGEFIELD was void of early speed, had a late rally in the stretch and was gaining, got through along the inside late. BLACKHAWK RED stalked the pace from the outside, rallied on the backstretch and took the lead, failed to sustain the bid and ran evenly late. TOO BOLD TO HOLD was well placed and showed good early speed, flattened out and ran evenly late. SMOKY STORM was unhurried early, improved position in the stretch. SEINNE SHIP showed good early speed chasing the pace, faltered and faded. NATIONALITY set the pace with good early speed, gave way and dropped back. RULE MY HEART failed to menace. DOUBLE WHY was no factor.
