ICE BREAKER was void of early speed, had a late rally and was gaining but too late. SMILAN IN MILAN stalked the pace while never far back, ran evenly with no rally. SIR P. T. CHALONE was off slowly, rallied into the stretch, failed to sustain the bid and ran evenly late. ANOTHER BULL RUN set the pace with good early speed, faltered and faded. I'LL TAKE JACKS failed to menace. PHIL'S BOY flashed brief speed before stopping.
