ROCKIN INTHE RAIN set all pace from well of the rail, stayed clear into the final furlong and had enough left to hang on. DANCING MARY chased winner from well off the inside but could not get past that one in the late going. BIG SIS AND TWINS never far back from close to the rail throughout with no late gain in the stretch run. IRISH VISION raced a wide trip throughout, moved up while while no real threat. HURRICANE GUSSIE stayed well off the rail throughout while never a menace. NO EXPOSURE angled in soon after the start, stayed inside throughout with little chance. THELMA'S SONGCAT stayed close from well off the rail for three quarters but gave way in the stretch. GIRL SLEUTH trailed while racing wide, pulled up in distress at the furlong pole and was subsequently vanned off.
