**Footnotes**

WILL E SCAT sat just off the pace, rallied from well off rail into the stretch and edged clear late. BLACKFOOT TRAIL had speed from close to the rail, stayed well to deep stretch but was run down at the wire. CATARIAT showed no speed to the stretch angled widest for the drive and was gaining too late. VALID IN PROGRESS raced up close to the stretch off the rail, went to inside in the late going with no gain. CHASE THE BLAZE raced evenly while well off the rail throughout. FEASTORFAMINE out sprinted from the gate, chased to the stretch and weakened. MYMANMAX never far back, switched to the inside through the stretch run and failed to gain. JUST DAZZLING was outrun. HUBBERT'S PEAK was never a factor. RESTLESS CITY trailed to the final furlong and passed one late. JULIA'S POSSE was through early and steadily dropped back.
