LUCKIE CHUCKIE chased the pace early, angled into the three path in the far turn then made a bid in the stretch while three wide and edged past the leaders in the late stages. SEND A SPIRIT pressed the pace early, angled off the rail into the far turn with a long drive in the stretch from between horses but missed late. FORTY TEARS set the pace early, while on the inside into the far turn with a long drive in the stretch from the inside and was caught in the final stages. BIMINI STORM stalked the pace early then had no room in the far turn from the inside then was blocked the entire stretch. TOO BOLD TO HOLD angled into the five path in the far turn and improved position. AWESOME BRADY angled into the four path in the far turn and flattened out late in the stretch drive. ZEBULON ROAD was through after a half. FIRST HOOT was pulled up and vanned off.
