YANKEE ROAD set the pace racing off the inside, bore out entering the lane, widened to the wire under urging. R AND R EXPRESS raced close up early, made a bid outside of the winner on the turn, was floated out by that rival approaching the stretch, proved no match through the lane and just held second. CAST NO SHADOW raced in midpack on the backstretch, was between rivals on the turn, did not rally. WININGS WIN WINNER was outrun to the stretch and passed only tired foes. J HALL raced three wide in midpack on the turn, gave way through the stretch. JERAMIAH JOHN chased the winner from the rail to the stretch before tiring. SPEEDY ORDEAL broke down entering the turn.
