KESAGAMI was unhurried early while on the inside, was angled out on the turn and rallied into the stretch, closed with a rush and drew off late under firm handling. DETROIT'S DANCER was void of early speed, rallied into the stretch and got through along the rail, failed to sustain the bid and ran evenly late. MOONSHINE STILL was in a good stalking position while four wide, rallied into the stretch and led, weakened and ran evenly late. SHAREHOLDER DUES was unhurried early, had a late rally in the stretch and was gaining but too late. LUCCIROCKINBUCCI was void of early speed, passed tiring rivals and ran evenly late. FRENCHMAN'S COVE flashed brief speed, gave way and dropped back. GOOD AND FAST showed good early speed chasing the pace, faltered and faded. STAR CARSON set the pace early, stopped in the stretch and dropped back. FORPETEYSSAKE dueled for the lead early, weakened and faded readily.
