KEYS TO ANNA had an awkward start, recovered and rallied five wide into the stretch to wear down rivals in the final strides. DONNIES MISTY bobbled at the start, went to gain the lead into the stretch but was run down at the wire in a good effort. DROPLET had no speed to the stretch, fanned widest for the drive to be gaining late. SKIP THE PAGE raced evenly to the stretch while mid track with no late gain. MARY MARIE dwelt at the start and passed tired ones from inside through the final furlong. DAN'S MORNING SKY stayed close to the stretch but weakened in the drive. JILL LYNN JONES had good position to the stretch and was ridden hard through the final furlong but stopped from inside. SOUTHERN SWEET TEA had good speed for a half and stopped badly thereafter.
