FLYING PURGE stalked the pace while never far back, rallied into the stretch and had a large lead, was all out to last late. LOOKING DUBAI was well placed while five wide, had a late rally and was gaining but too late. VIRGINIA AND TONIC was in a good stalking position while five wide, had a late rally and was gaining but too late. MINON was unhurried early while five wide, had a mild late rally and some late gain. FLYS THRU THE SKY was void of early speed, also had a mild late rally but too late. DELROY'S BARMAID showed good early speed chasing the pace, faltered and faded. KATELYN GIRL failed to menace. CHELSEA'SMOUNTAIN was no threat. ONE GAME DAME flashed brief speed before stopping. NAPOTE set the pace with good early speed, gave way and dropped back. CONTEZZA was no factor.
