THANKS BE TO GOD well placed from inside, angled out into the stretch run, split horses inside the eighth pole and edged clear late. HONOUR ABOVE SELF sprinted to a long lead to deep stretch and was all out to hang on for the place spot. STEPHEN'S QUEST secured good position, came four wide into the stretch with a menacing bid but was outfinished late. CHOW WAGON had no speed to the stretch and rallied through the drive to close the gap. NUMEROUS ONE chased leader for three quarters but gave way and was in tight and bounced around at the eighth pole while tiring in the drive. OPTIMER (ARG) raced just off the rail the entire trip and failed to menace. MOROX was never a menace. BUCKEYE'S PRIZE raced a wide trip while never a threat and appeared to labor in the final furlong.
