VALUED ASSETS broke well, tracked leaders to the stretch, roused and responded well to run past late. SILVER WARD had good speed to set a pressured pace, swerved out a bit in the drive but held the place spot. THOROUGHBRED ED prompted the pace to deep stretch, altered course to the inside through the late going when SILVER WARD swerved out but weakened in the drive. SMOKIN RASCAL rated just off pace to the stretch but weakened through the final furlong. EXCITING BAND was bothered at the start and never a threat. BIG BLUE FEVER was never a threat. SKIPPIN GOOD TIME dropped back.
