CARR POOL tracked to the final turn, angled out at the quarter pole and drew off in the final furlong. DONNIE LEE had good speed to set the pace for three quarters but was no match for the winner but clearly second best. UNCLE LES never far back, fanned wide into the stretch but had no late gain in the drive. ETERNAL CRAFT raced up close early on, dropped back and had no bid in the drive. CHAPIN RIDGE was no real menace. HEPHAESTUS chased the leader for a half from inside but dropped back thereafter. HALLINGNHESTAKES was never a threat. TOOTHMOVER was no factor. BAD AS BOB had a steady fade. CLAY'S DREAMER always trailed.
