STALWART TEE dueled for the lead and set the pace while saving ground, was headed on the far turn, was well handled and had something left when asked, was fully extended to the wire. SUDDENLY PERFECT was in a good stalking position on the inside in mid pack, had a late rally and was gaining but too late. HE'S A BIG DADDY was void of early speed while six wide, had a late rally in the stretch and was also gaining but too late. EOLOS prompted the pace and dueled for the lead from the outside, weakened in the stretch and ran evenly late. APACHE STORM was unhurried early while five wide, rallied on the far turn, hung in the stretch and ran evenly late. CALIFORNIA LION bobbled at the start, failed to menace.
