NOT ENUFF JUSTICE dueled for the lead and pressed the pace while saving ground, drew off in upper stretch and was fully extended to the wire. LEEDONNA broke in the air and then stalked the pace, was taken up entering the turn, had a mild late rally and some late gain. THUNDER OF HOPE dueled for the lead and set the pace, faltered and faded. LUNAR FEST was in a good stalking position while five wide and lost ground, had no rally. DELITEFULLY WILD was well placed while five wide, ran evenly with no rally. MAZEY TWEENY flashed brief speed, was through after a half mile and dropped back. WEEKWEE failed to menace. WAHL OF FAME was no threat. BLITZ IT AGAIN flashed brief speed before stopping.
