GENERAL LAFAYETTE was well placed in mid pack, rallied into the stretch on the inside and drew off in upper stretch, was fully extended to hold the margin late. SIX TOKENS set the pace with good early speed, could not go with and was no match for the winner, was second best. KENTUCKY BRIGHTS was void of early speed, had a late rally and was gaining but too late. CHARMED CAT was void of early speed, rallied on the far turn and gained ground, failed to sustain the bid and hung, had a nice middle move. PLATELETS showed good early speed, gave way and dropped back. MIMI'S MIRAGE was well placed early, rallied on the second turn, failed to sustain the bid and dropped back. ENTICEMENT showed good early speed chasing the pace, faltered and faded. THETIGERMAN stalked the pace from id pack, ran evenly with no rally. FASTTRUCKSNFREEDOM failed to menace. AUSTIN ECHO stumbled and lost the rider at the start.
