STARTIN SOMETHING quickly to the front and dictated the pace throughout under confident handling, widened in the stretch run with no challengers in the final furlong. SHEZA RUNAWAY STAR chased from inside for three quarters, angled widest into the stretch for place while no match for the winner. DERBY DAY STORM pressed the winner for three quarters, put to a drive but could not keep up from the quarter pole and faded in the drive. TUT'S SHADOW well placed while never far back for three quarters but faded thereafter. SWISS MISS TOO unhurried early, made a good middle move between horses going to the three quarters but could not sustain the bid CHILD PROOF was never a menace. FLOPSY was through after a half and dropped far back.
