MADE THE STEAL was away alertly and set the pace while off the rail, drew off in upper stretch and was under firm handling to the wire. BOHEMIAN DREAM stalked the pace while never far back on the outside, could not get to and was no match for the winner, was second best. PEACE AND JOY showed good early speed chasing the pace, gave way and dropped back. BAD BIG AL was well placed in mid pack, ran evenly with no rally. TROUTDALE failed to menace. WILL E SCAT was no threat. DIAMOND ROLL showed brief speed chasing the pace, gave way and dropped back. JOHN THE BANKER was no factor.
