INDIAN INK was away quickly and set all of the pace while saving ground, responded when asked and drew off in upper stretch, was under firm handling to the wire. GATHERING DREAMS was well placed in mid pack, rallied on the far turn, flattened out and ran evenly late, gamely held the place. STARTIN SOMETHING stalked the pace while four wide, rallied on the second turn, failed to sustain the bid and flattened out. T. T.'S SURPRISE was void of early speed, improved position. PRINCESS CHRISTINE showed good early speed, gave way and dropped back. STAR AWARD failed to menace. DERBY DAY STORM pressed the pace from the outside early, was through after a half mile and dropped back.
