**Footnotes**

J. R.'S TOWN saved ground racing well off the pace to the stretch, split horses entering the lane and again while rallying in midstretch, took the lead inside the final sixteenth and gamely prevailed under urging. DISAPPEARANCE raced well off the pace on the turn, angled out five wide while splitting horses into the lane, rallied in tandem with and to the outside of the winner through the final furlong but could not match strides late. ROLLIN ME OUT went clear approaching the turn, widened around the bend, took a commanding lead in upper stretch but weakened late. DEVIL'S JUDGE raced between horses in the second flight around the turn, chased the pacesetter into the lane but failed to produce a rally. EXCLUSIVE DAWN trailed to the stretch, swung eight wide entering the lane and had a mild rally. ONE BAD DUDE raced close up while four wide around the turn, weakened. SCIOTO BOOTSKI chased the pace from between horses on the backstretch and along the rail around the turn before giving way. WRECKING CREW was ridden along to show speed from the rail on the backstretch, couldn't keep pace entering the turn and dropped back. MARK'S GREEN COAT raced four wide on the turn and was never a factor. TEXAS CODE raced in midpack to the stretch before dropping back. LAKE BREEZE chased the pace racing three wide to the stretch, tired.
