Footnotes

STOW IT showed sharp speed to clear for the lead from outside into first turn, set all pace and stayed clear through the drive. BENDIDIT close up around the first turn, shuffled back after a half and came again for place in the stretch run. ELECTRIC STRIDE well placed while never far back, angled out sharply in the stretch but lacked the late response needed. YOUTHFUL SPIRIT chased the winner to deep stretch but faded. EL OF A RASH had no speed to the stretch, came widest in the drive and moved up a bit while no real threat. JAMAICA LANE raced in striking position for three quarters but faded thereafter. MO' TERMS failed to menace. J. Z. RIB never a factor. LITTLE GANGSTER had a steady fade.
