VALID IN PROGRESS just off the pace, rallied three wide into the turn, drew clear in the stretch and held on late. ZYDACO had no speed to the quarter pole, swung widest into the stretch and was gaining late. SWEET LITTLE DIXIE inside run to the quarter pole, angled out for the drive with a late gain. EL QUIXOTE close up with pace from four wide to the stretch but had no late gain in the lane. BLACKFOOT TRAIL pressed pace to the quarter pole, stayed well in the lane but weakened late. FEASTORFAMINE had good speed from closest to the rail but gave way through the stretch run. MR FARNSWORTH failed to menace. SILVER TALK RIB was outrun. NAPOLEON J was through early from inside in the stretch run.
