O'RIAIN was unhurried early on the inside, rallied into the stretch and was angled out, was all out to get up in the final stride. QUEENS TONY dueled for the lead and set the pace, drew off on the turn and had a large lead late, led to the final jump and was outfinished to the wire. ALLADINS CLOUD was well placed while five wide, had a mild late rally and some late gain but too late. MARCO REGS WINNER was unhurried early on the inside, had a mild late rally. MUSIC FAN dueled for the lead and prompted the pace, weakened in the stretch and began to fade. BABA BOOEY failed to menace. POWERBALL TOO was off slowly and was never a factor. MCFRENCH flashed brief speed, was steadied on the turn and dropped back.
