WANDERING MANN well placed to the turn, came three wide into the stretch, roused and drew off while wide through the final furlong. LITTLE LUCK had good speed from outside, got to the inside, stayed well to the furlong grounds but was run down. SUNNY SQUALL never far back from inside but failed to respond in the drive. ARRESTEDBYMISTAKE bore out at start and raced wide throughout, swung widest with a late rally and mild gain in the stretch. PROUD MONKEY with the pace to the quarter pole from just off rail but weakened in the drive. WILD SKATER was pinched back at the start, rushed five wide and stayed mid track to the finish. QUICK CARNAGE was never a real threat. SPEAKING OUT was no factor. JERSEYS BREW was through early. MR. INDIGO was bothered at the start, never recovered and trailed far back.
