POSITIVE CASH FLOW never far back, four wide into stretch and drew off from out in the middle of the track. TOO TOO CRAFTY with pace from close to the rail, made an inside run through the stretch while no match late. MOON IS A STAR pressed the pace, led into the turn but could not keep up and weakened in the stretch run. HOUSEBUILDER raced evenly and failed to respond in the drive. CUCINA NICK had no speed to the stretch and had off rail improvement in the stretch. MAKERS AT MIDNIGHT with the pace to the turn but gave way from outside. COLERIDGE failed to menace. HIGH HAT MATT had no speed, came wide into stretch while no real no threat. CAPTAIN BRY had an inside trip while no threat. LONG POND was never a factor while wide. IWO HERO saved ground to no avail.
