**Footnotes**

ASP stalked the pace while never far back on the outside, rallied into the stretch and wore down the leaders, drew clear under heavy pressure. SOUTHALL was in a good stalking position in mid pack, rallied into the stretch and dueled for the lead, could not go with the winner but gamely held the place. ALL TRUE was well placed on the outside while never far back, rallied into the stretch, failed to sustain the bid and ran evenly late. GOIN ON A HUNCH stalked the pace on the inside, rallied into the stretch and loomed boldly, failed to sustain the bid and began to fade. TOP APPEAL dueled for the lead early, was through after a half mile and dropped back. HASTEGO was void of early speed, had a mild late rally and some late gain. MISTER MACHO was unhurried early, rallied into the stretch, faltered and faded. CHASE THE BLAZE was in a good stalking position in mid pack, ran evenly with no rally. JIM'S DEPUTY flashed brief speed chasing the pace, stopped and dropped back. GOLDEN LACES was no factor while wide and lost ground. LEO AND MIKE failed to menace while seven wide and lost ground. MAKERS AT MIDNIGHT showed good early speed setting the pace, was through after a half mile and gave way readily.
